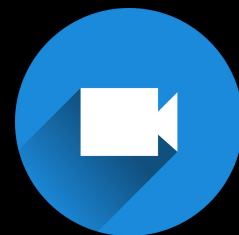


Tips and Expectations for Student Use of Google Meet

Don'ts



1. Show up on time. Make sure your video is on so you can be seen.	1. Chew gum, eat snacks, or drink while on video.
2. Find a quiet place, away from distractions (siblings, pets, TV, etc.).	2. Save, record, screenshot, share, or post ANYTHING from the Meet.
3. Keep your microphone on mute UNLESS called on to speak by the teacher.	3. Be in a noisy location.
4. Raise your hand if you'd like to speak.	4. Turn the microphone off/on, unless asked to contribute.
5. If you have a question put it in the side chat bar.	5. Engage in games through other tabs, music, or have chats open.
6. Keep cell phones out of view.	6. Distract others.
7. Stay on topic and participate	7. Continually move around.
8. Look into the camera when you are talking.	8. Be in your bathroom.
9. Students should be dressed for school.
